

- > Number of projects that took at least 100 calendar days to approve: 48




### **All Open Projects - Level of Review**








### **All Open Projects - Current Level of Review**



# Number of New Projects Received by Month total = 1003







# 2010 Submissions by PI/Co-PI Total number of investigators: 1045


















### **Distribution of Funding Source for 2010 New Projects**






### **Age of Open Projects**



### **Time from Receipt to Approval**






