EXPORT CONTROL CHECKLIST REVIEW IS REQUIRED <i>PRIOR</i> TO ACCEPTANCE OF ALL SPONSORED AGREEMENTS IF ANY OF THE CRITERIA IN THE INSTRUCTIONS OR CHECKLIST ARE MET:						
A.	If <u>Restricted Party Screening (RPS)</u> * of DCCs or non-UA personnel, companies, institutions, etc., results in a potential match. Use Descartes Visual Compliance to screen. Contact Export Control if you have questions, or you are unsure who conducts screenings in your department.					
	*To remain compliant with federal regulations, the University of Arizona conducts Restricted Party Screenings (RPS) to help prevent illegal transactions with restricted foreign and domestic parties.
