Export Control review is required <i>prior</i> to acceptance of agreements if any of the following criteria are met:										
1.	Restricted Party Screening (RPS)* of any UA or non-UA personnel, companies, institutions, etc., results in a potential match. Contact Export Control if you are unsure who your departmental screener is. *To remain compliant with federal regulations, the University of Arizona conducts Restricted Party Screenings (RPS) to help									
	prevent illegal transactions with restricted foreign and domestic parties.
