



Human Subjects Training Requirements

Human Subjects Training is required for all Investigators, Faculty, Staff and Students conducting research with human subjects at the University of Arizona.

There are two CITI Training options for Investigators to choose from, depending on the type of research they will be conducting:

Social & Behavioral Research BASIC Course *or* Biomedical Research BASIC Course



Required for Non-Medical Surveys, Interviews, etc.



Required for Clinical Trials, MR Reviews, etc.

- Both training courses include the **Native American Research Module**, which is required training for all University of Arizona researchers.
- Both CITI certificates are valid for **four (4) years**, after which **refresher** training must be completed.
- Please keep a copy of your training certificate for your records.
