
RLSS CHEMICAL INCIDENT RESPONSE FLOWCHART

Ventilated Enclosures can be fume hoods, biosafety cabinets, glove boxes, etc.

Hazardous Gases can be toxic, pyrophoric and/or corrosive or any combination of each.

A <u>Major Spill</u> is defined as a life and environmentally threatining release of toxic, pyrophoric, self-reactive, or flammable chemicals that may expose others through the building ventilation system.

A Minor Spill is defined as a maneagable or small release of chemicals not defined under a Major Spill.

Only trained lab workers should clean or control hazardous material spills or gas leaks.
